

Pray the Book of Acts Over Your City

"Pray at all times in the Spirit" (Ephesians 6:18)

Day One

Pray, "Thy Kingdom Come."

"But ye shall receive Power, after that the Holy Ghost is come upon you" (Acts 1:1-14).

Entreat: The Lord to loose the spirit of prayer and supplication in your church: Matthew 21:13; Acts 1: 14; 1 Thessalonians 5:17.

Ask: Jesus to fill every ministry of your church with the power of the Holy Ghost: Luke 11:9-13; Acts 1:8.

Day Two

Pray for Power in Apostolic Preaching (Acts 2:1-4).

"...In the last days, saith God, I will pour out of my Spirit upon all flesh " (Acts 2.17).

Petition: That Jesus would be lifted up before all men: John 12:32; Acts 2:36; Colossians 1:28.

Claim: Apostolic results of repentance, water baptism in Jesus' name and the infilling of the Holy Ghost with the evidence of speaking with other tongues: Mark 16:15-20; Acts 2:37-38, 4:30.

Invite: The Lord to add to your number daily such as should be saved: Acts 2:47; 4:4; 5:14; 6:7; 8: 12; 9:31; 11:2 1 and 12:24.

Day Three

Pray for Boldness in Jesus' Name (Acts 3:1-21).

Pray: In Jesus' name for the sick to be healed: Luke 10:9 and Acts 3:6.

Praise: His name for signs and wonders to confirm the word: John 14:12.

Day Four

Pray for Deliverance from Evil (Acts 4).

Bind: In Jesus' name, the powers of darkness resisting the gospel: Matt. 18:18-19.

Request: Boldness for your pastor and church leaders to preach the complete Apostolic message of truth: Acts 4:31.

Day Five

Pray for Evangelistic Outreach (Acts 8).

"And there was great joy in that city" (Acts 8:8).

Intercede: That the gospel will be preached where it has not been heard: Acts 8:4; Matthew 28:19.

Seek: God for leaders within governments to be saved as the Ethiopian leader: Acts 8:35; II Timothy 2:1-6.

Day Six

Pray for Miraculous Conversions (Acts 9:1-31).

Believe: God for sinners to be arrested with a "Damascus Road" experience: Acts I:1-6 and John 16:7-11.

Raise: Up, Lord, disciples like Ananias and Barnabas to build bridges for new converts to be accepted into the church: Acts 9:15, 27, 31.

Day Seven

Pray for a Harvest of Households & Families (Acts 10).

Boldly: Pray for an alignment between those ready to hear like Cornelius and those ready to tell like Peter: Acts 10:2, 23.

Diligently: Ask for the Holy Ghost to draw whole households to the church: Matthew 2:21; Acts 10:44 and Hebrews 11:6.

Day Eight

Pray for the Persecuted (Acts 12:1-17).

Earnestly: Pray for every ministry, especially your pastor, to be liberated from every prison to freely proclaim the Apostolic message with power.

Rebuke: In Jesus' name, the oppression and persecution of suffering Christians in other nations: Colossians 2:2-3 and Philipians 1:12.

Day Nine

Pray for Dynamic Worship Services to Convict Sinners (Acts 16:16-34).

Agree: In prayer for a renewal of worship and praise in your church: Psalm 85:6 and Matthew 18:18.

Expect: A spirit of conviction of sin and a desire for conversion to permeate every worship service: Acts 16:30 and Romans 1:16.

Day Ten

Pray for your Pastor and Church Leaders (Acts 28:1-10).

Covet: In prayer a Spirit of steadfastness to complete this ministry, to the end: I Corinthians 15:58 and I Timothy 6:12.

Resist: In Jesus' name, attacks on your pastor and church leadership: Acts 20:28-31 and II Timothy 4:17-18.

"And the disciples were filled with Joy, and with the Holy Ghost" (Acts 13:52). "And the hand of the Lord was with them: and a great number believed, and turned unto the Lord" (Acts 11:21).

Encourage others to pray with you that another chapter of Acts will be experienced in your city (Acts 1:14).
